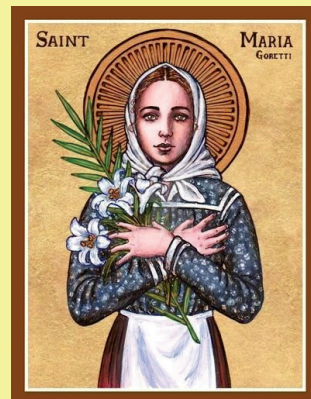

Among many other things that are celebrated during this month, May is also the month of the Blessed Virgin Mary. As we do each year, we will celebrate a May Crowning next week on Mother's Day weekend. At the 9:30am Mass on May 14th, members of our HVM Women's Club will crown our statue of the Blessed Mother, and at the 11:30am Mass that day, our Religious Ed. First Communicants will participate in the crowning.

And speaking of our First Communicants, I would like to congratulate our 2nd Grade and Sacramental Prep. Rel. Ed. students who are making their First Holy Communion this month. Some of the students received their First Communion on Saturday, May 6th, and some of them will receive it on Saturday, May 13th. Please pray that our R.E. children will have a beautiful experience of God's love given to them for the first time in the Eucharist.

We're only two weeks away from our first HVM Spring Dinner & Raffle. It will take place on Saturday, May 20th in our new Hendle Hall. The raffle will offer five cash prizes: \$4,000, \$2,000, \$500, \$300, and \$200. You also have the option of buying two types of tickets, and please make sure that you are aware of the difference before you buy your ticket! The yellow \$50 ticket gives you one entry into the raffle, but no admission to the dinner. However, please know that you do not need to be present at the dinner to win a raffle prize. In addition, we will livestream the raffle drawing; there will be a link posted on our parish website closer to the event.

Tickets are on sale at the back of church after weekend Masses, and you can purchase by cash, check, or credit card (please be aware that there is a \$5.00 processing fee for credit card purchases). You can also buy tickets at the rectory. Please also be aware that next weekend, May 13-14, will be the final weekend to buy the purple dinner/raffle tickets, as we will need time to give a head count to the caterer. However, you can buy the yellow raffle tickets all the way up to and including the night of the drawing.

I hope that you can join us on May 20th, especially if you have not yet seen Hendle Hall. But even if you cannot attend the dinner, I hope that you can support HVM Parish with our new fundraiser.

**Receive The Blessed Sacrament of Holy Communion**

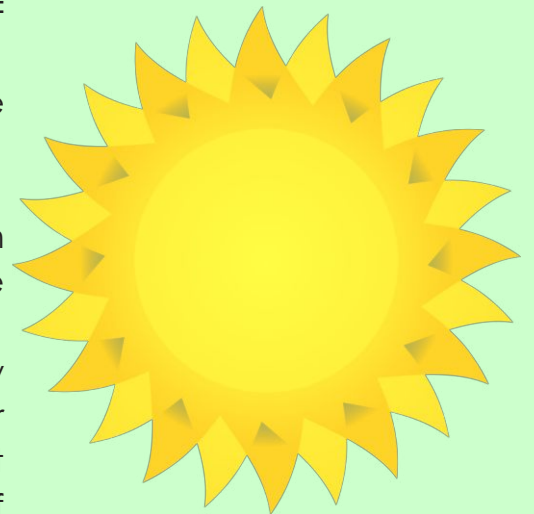

Notes From The Parish Nurse...

Happy and Healthy Spring to all of you!

With spring in the air, I thought it was important to mention that May is Skin Cancer Awareness Month. As we are spending more time in the sun, I wanted to remind you about the importance of wearing sun screen and protective clothing and accessories such as wide-brimmed hats and sunglasses to help protect from the sun's harmful UV rays.


The American Academy of Dermatology recommends that your sunscreen be broad-spectrum protecting against UVA and UVB rays), SPF 30 or higher, and water resistant. The Skin Cancer Foundation advises to apply one ounce of sunscreen to the entire body 30 minutes before going outside, and to reapply every 2 hours after swimming or sweating. Also, to seek shade (especially between the hours of 10am and 4pm), and to examine your skin from head to toe monthly, seeing a dermatologist at least yearly for a professional skin exam. Remember to report anything new or changing or unusual that you notice on your skin to your medical provider. For more information you can contact the Skin Cancer Foundation or the American Academy of Dermatology.



Additionally one of my roles as a community nurse is to help maintain the Micro Pantry at Ascension Resurrection, located outside of the ER entrance. The Micro Pantry holds food and personal items that are donated to help respond to the short term basic needs of those who may not otherwise have access. There is always a need for donations. For the month of May, I will be having a food drive for peanut butter in plastic containers up to 18oz to help restock the Micro Pantry. There will be a donation box in the vestibule of church.
