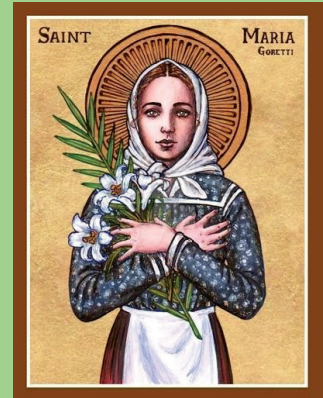

From the Pastor's Desk

Next month the Chicago Archdiocese will host its annual Golden Anniversary Mass for couples around the Archdiocese for are celebrating their 50th wedding anniversary this year. If you were married in 1973 and would like to attend the Golden Anniversary Mass, it will take place on Sunday, September 17th at 2:30pm at Holy Name Cathedral. Cardinal Cupich will be the celebrant. You are required to register for the Mass beforehand. To do so, go to pvm.archchicago.org/events/golden-wedding. If you have any questions, please send an email to gwa@archchicago.org. There is also an ad for the 50th Mass in this bulletin.

Several things begin again here at the parish beginning in September, and that includes our Religious Education classes for Grades K-8. Classes are offered on Tuesday evenings or Saturday mornings, and they run from September through April. You can register your child(ren) online by going to www.hvmparish.org, click on the Religious Education tab, and then scroll down and click on the Registration Form. You can also register by arriving early on the first day of class – the first Saturday class is 9:00am on Sep. 9th, and the first Tuesday class is 6:00pm on Sep. 12th.

Another set of classes that begin in September is for our RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). This is for adults who seek to become full members of the Catholic Church through Baptism (if needed), Eucharist and Confirmation. RCIA classes will begin soon, and they lead up to Easter of next year (RCIA candidates are always received into the Church at the Easter Vigil Mass). If you or someone you know is considering becoming a fully initiated member of the Catholic Church, please contact the rectory at 847-678-0138 or hvm-parish@outlook.com so that we can put you in touch with our RCIA coordinator. You can also fill out an inquiry form on our website at www.hvmparish.org/becoming-catholic.

Don't forget that time is running out to take part in one of our popular fundraisers. Our Football Mania (FM) fundraiser is based on the NFL regular season schedule. Each FM ticket gives you 18 chances to win, one chance for each week of the season. FM tickets are \$20 each. The weekly prizes range from \$25 to \$400. There is a guaranteed winner each week, and it is possible to win more than once with one ticket. Tickets are on sale from now, but the last day to purchase tickets will be Tuesday, Sep. 5th. You can buy tickets at the back of church after Mass, at the rectory, or by contacting the rectory.

Finally, our Summer Mission Appeal speaker this year will be a priest with whom some of our parishioners are quite familiar. Fr. Stan Ilo is a professor at DePaul University. For many years, he helped with weekend Masses at one of our legacy parishes, St. Maria Goretti. I'm happy that Fr. Stan will be giving our 2023 Summer Appeal this year. He will be presiding and speaking at all the Masses next weekend, Sep. 2-3. Please note that Fr. Stan will not be able to hear confessions this coming Saturday, so **there will be no 3:30pm confessions on Saturday, Sep. 2nd**.

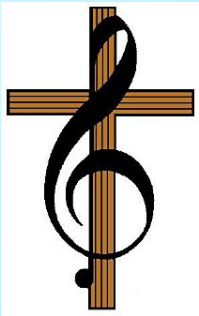

An estimated 40 million Americans are coping with some form of anxiety and 70 percent of Americans say the coronavirus outbreak is a new source of stress in their lives.

Mental Health First Aid is an internationally recognized course that will teach participants how to identify, understand and respond to signs of mental illness and substance use disorders. This training teaches how to help another person who may be experiencing a mental health or addiction challenge.

Participants are expected to invest two hours of self-paced study in addition to six hours of live training via Zoom. CEU are available. Registration for each class is limited to 25 people to allow for more personalized instruction and interactive discussion.
