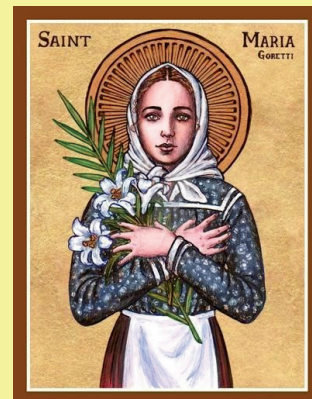

From the Pastor's Desk

Even though this is a holiday weekend (and I hope you all had a Blessed Thanksgiving), we have a lot to squeeze into the bulletin for today and the next few weeks, so my article might be a little shorter than usual. So let me get right into it and touch on several items here.

First, I would like to thank the members of our parish Women's Club for another successful Bake Sale last weekend. I also want to thank all the wonderful parishioners who generously donated items to the sale, as well as all those who stopped by to purchase items. Thank you all!

I would also like to thank all those who have donated and are still donating to my race fundraiser for the church carpeting. We've currently collected over \$29,000. Thank you!

I also want to share with you our parish Annual Report for FY2022-23, which is included in this bulletin. Thanks to the generosity of those who give to our Sunday collection, as well as the extraordinary gifts that we receive throughout the year, I'm happy to report that we are in the black. While this is good news, please keep in mind that this was largely due to a significant bequest that we received. I only mention that to emphasize the point that we continue to greatly rely on your generosity to our Sunday collection. Extraordinary gifts are extremely helpful, but the Sunday collection is what keeps us going week by week.

This week our Knights of Columbus are hosting a Rosary for Peace. As war continues to be waged in the Middle East and in Europe, it is very important for us as people of faith to pray for our brothers and sisters around the world who are affected by war and violence. I hope you can join us in praying this Rosary for Peace on Wednesday, Nov. 29th at 7:00pm in church.

Finally, I hope that you can make plans to join us for our annual Parish Christmas Party. It will take place on Sunday, Dec. 10th at Allegra Banquets in Schiller Park. Doors open at 2pm, and dinner will be served at 3pm, with a cash bar. Dinner tickets are \$35. You can buy them at Mass this weekend and next, or anytime at the rectory until Dec. 6th. In addition to the dinner tickets, we are also selling raffle tickets. At the Christmas Party, we will have a raffle for several prizes, including gift baskets, as well as several cash prizes: three \$100 prizes, one \$200 prize, and one \$500 grand prize. Raffle tickets (sold separately from the dinner tickets) are \$5 each, or six for \$25. And you do not need to be present at the Christmas Party to win.

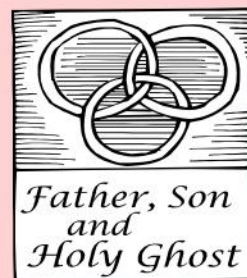
