From the Pastor's Desk

Here we are on the First Sunday of Lent. This 40-day journey towards Easter is an important time in the liturgical calendar. For instance, did you make any New Year's resolutions? Well, if those have perhaps fallen by the wayside, use this Lenten season to try again! Or if you didn't make any resolutions, why don't you set a goal for Lent? You can either choose to give something up, or perhaps try to add something to your daily or weekly routine. Either way, the goal for us during Lent is to let go of the some of the things in this world that take up too much of our attention, and instead focus that attention on God and His will for us.

As part of your Lenten journey, I hope you can join us for some prayer opportunities here at the parish. Every Friday at 6:30pm during Lent (through March 22nd) we pray the Stations of the Cross, followed by Eucharistic Benediction. I invite you to join us on any of these Fridays, especially if you've never experienced the Stations and/or Benediction before. And yes, this would mean giving up a little time on a Friday night (only about 45 minutes), but isn't Lent about making sacrifices?

One of our main opportunities for spiritual growth this Lent will be our parish Mission. Please mark your calendar for our Lenten Mission, which will take place on Mon.-Thurs., March 11-14. Our speaker will again be Fr. Michael Moore of the St. Patrick Fathers. The title of his mission is "Compassion On Our Spiritual Journey." Fr. Moore will celebrate Mass at 8:30am & 7:00pm on each of those four days, and his talk will be part of the Mass. It will be the same talk in the morning and the evening, so you have two opportunities to attend on each day.

I do need to mention a few non-Lenten things this week. First, this is the Follow-Up (and final!) Weekend of the 2024 Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA). I thank all of you who have already made a pledge to this year's ACA to help us surpass our assigned goal of \$23,122. For those who may not have pledged yet, we offer this Follow-Up Weekend as an opportunity to do so. Please consider making a pledge by either using the ACA envelopes in church and dropping them in Sunday collection on any weekend, or you can pledge anytime online by going to our website at www.hvmparish.org, or go to www.annualcatholicappeal.com. Whichever way you choose to pledge, please remember to designate Holy Virgin Martyrs as the parish where you want to credit your gift so that your donation will count towards our goal.

I also want to remind everyone that this week we are offering a second training for new altar servers. This very important ministry is open to both children and adults (the one requirement is that you need to have made your First Communion). The next training will take place this Monday, Feb. 19th at 7:00pm in church. Also, all <u>current</u> altar servers are required to attend this training if you missed the one on Feb. 17th. We want to make sure that our current servers will be on the same page with our new servers.

Finally, if you happened to attend our Holy Thursday Mass last year, you saw us bless and dedicate our new ambry, which contains the three oils used in Catholic sacraments. Our new ambry is located on the front wall of church, near the left side altar. The ambry was generously made and donated by a parishioner. Well, that same parishioner has now also made and donated a new reliquary for our parish. A reliquary contains the relics of saints (relics are typically saints' bone fragments, but can also be things like pieces of their clothing). Our new reliquary is located right where the ambry is, but near the right side altar (so, same location, but opposite side). We blessed and dedicated our new reliquary at our recent Ash Wednesday Masses. And our reliquary, of course, contains the relics of our two patron saints, St. Beatrice and St. Maria Goretti, Virgin Martyrs of the Church. Thank you again to our generous parishioner!

Holy Virgin Martyrs, pray for us. May God bless you.


