From the Pastor's Desk

This weekend we are happy to welcome back Fr. Michael Moore of the St. Patrick Fathers. Fr. Moore is speaking at all the Masses this weekend to promote **our 2024 Lenten Mission, which will take place this coming week**. His Mission is entitled, "Compassion on Our Spiritual Journey."

Fr. Moore will celebrate Mass on each of the four days of the Mission, and his presentation will take place during the homily. The Mass and talk will be offered twice each day, from March 11-14, at 8:30am and 7:00pm (so, you have two options to attend). The titles of his talk on each day are:

Monday – Moved to Action and Flexibility

Tuesday – Jesus' Life on the Line

Wednesday – Our God of Second Chances

Thursday – The Commandments Made Simple

Fr. Moore is an inspiring mission speaker, and he was very well-received last year. Even if you cannot attend all four days, I encourage you to try to attend just one or two of them. I believe that you'll be glad that you did.

In addition, our **Lenten confessions will take place on Monday, March 18th at 7:00pm** in church. Several priests will be available that night for individual confessions. I hope you can take advantage of this great opportunity to prepare ourselves to celebrate Christ's Resurrection at Easter. And don't forget that we always have confessions every Saturday from 3:30-4:00pm in the Reconciliation Room near the church main entrance.

I also want to mention that this weekend is the 4th Sunday of Lent, which is also known as *Laetare* Sunday. Just as in Advent, we have a weekend during Lent where we rejoice that we are past the halfway point of the season, drawing closer to the celebration of Easter. So, on this Laetare (Rejoicing) Sunday, the priest celebrant has the option of wearing rose vestments, as this brighter color (compared to the violet of Lent) signifies our joy in drawing closer to Jesus' Resurrection.

Finally, I just want to offer two reminders regarding donations to the parish, as I have not mentioned these items in a while. First, please remember that if you ever write a check to the parish, it needs to be made out to "Holy Virgin Martyrs Parish." Since we received our new parish name, our bank has made it clear that they cannot accept checks made out to HVM Parish, or to Holy Virgin Martyrs. So, please remember to use the full name of Holy Virgin Martyrs Parish.

Second, don't forget that you can always donate to our parish online, and you can give either a one-time gift, or set up a recurring gift. Incidentally, setting up a recurring donation online makes it easier for us to budget and forecast our Sunday collections. 


