From the Pastor's Desk

Before I talk about what's going on at the parish, I want to offer some words of thanks. First, I would like to thank our decorators, our liturgical ministers, our music ministers, and anyone who volunteered in any way to make our Holy Week and Easter liturgies so beautiful. The Triduum liturgies require a lot of work, and I am grateful to everyone who helped with these liturgies in any way.

I would also like to extend my sincere gratitude to everyone who sent me Easter cards and gifts, as well as birthday cards and gifts. I turned 51 earlier this month, which I guess wasn't as traumatic as turning 50! I'm kidding about that, as it was not traumatic for me to turn 50 last year. After the death of my older sister in 2022, and as I get older, I come to appreciate more that life is short, and I'm just grateful to be alive each day and to be loved by God and by others. We have all lost loved ones, and we all have our challenges in life, but my prayer for all of you is that your faith in God gives you the strength, inspiration, courage, and vision to see that our time on earth is a gift to be enjoyed and to be used wisely, and that God has an even greater gift in store for us – the gift of eternal life.

And that is what we celebrate in this Easter season: the gift of eternal life that Jesus Christ has won for us by His death and resurrection. This gift was first offered to us on the day of our Baptism, which is why we focus on Baptism during the Easter season. One way that we do this is by using the Sprinkling Rite (in place of the normal Penitential Rite) at the beginning of our weekend Easter season Masses.

And because Baptism is a focus of Easter, this is why many parishes choose to celebrate the sacrament of Confirmation during the Easter season, as Confirmation is a completion of baptismal grace. We will celebrate Confirmation here at HVM this Tuesday, April 16th at 7:00pm, as our 8th grade Rel. Ed. students, as well as some adult candidates, will receive this powerful sacrament.

The celebrant for our Confirmation this year is Bishop Jeffrey Grob, who is the Vicar for Vicariate I (the northern section of the Chicago Archdiocese). Bishop Grob is a wonderful bishop whom I've had the pleasure to know since early on in my priesthood. He has served the Archdiocese in multiple capacities as both a priest and bishop, including as Judicial Vicar and then Chancellor of the Archdiocese. We are happy to welcome Bishop Grob for the first time to our parish!

Finally, I just want to again remind everyone what I spoke about at Mass last weekend. We are working on demolishing and removing the old air handler in church and replacing it with a new air handler / air conditioning rooftop unit. This job will continue into next month, and a lot of it depends on the weather. During this time, please remember that we will have no heat or air conditioning in church. We will try to get the job done ASAP, but again, the weather is a major factor in rooftop work. Thank you for your understanding.
