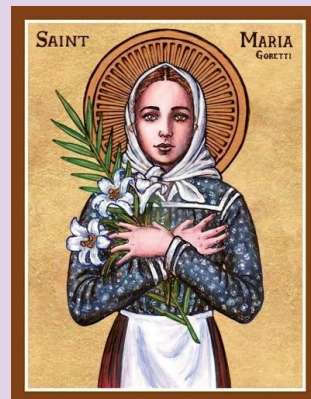

### *From the Pastor's Desk*

As I mentioned last weekend, we (and many other parishes in the Archdiocese) now have a new bulletin company, called Diocesan. This is our first bulletin to be published by them. Please keep in mind three things regarding this significant transition: (1) There may be some bumps in the road, so please be patient if there are any glitches with the bulletin in the coming weeks; (2) Because of costs and the need for more advertisers, there are now fewer pages in our bulletin, but on the other hand, there will be more electronic opportunities available in the future, including the possibility of having the bulletin emailed directly to you each week, and/or using a Diocesan app; (3) Diocesan has an earlier deadline for bulletin submissions, so if you want to include something in the bulletin, it needs to be submitted to the rectory 10 days before your desired weekend.

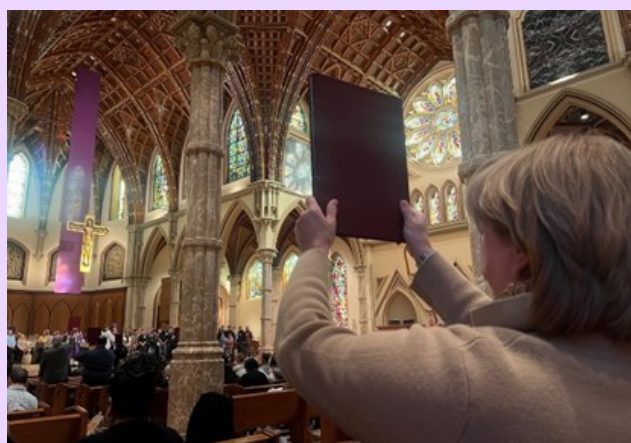
Please also mark your calendars for our **2023 Lenten Mission on March 20-23. It is entitled, "Letting Go Of Our Own Wounds So That We Can Be Instruments Of God's Love And Acceptance In Our Troubled World."** The Mission will be given by Fr. Michael Moore. His presentations will be given in the context of the Mass, and his talk will be repeated at both 8:30am and 7:00pm each day from March 20-23 (so you will have the option of attending either in the morning or the evening). The titles of his talks on each day are: **March 20 – God: Our Father and Source of Love; March 21 – The Wounds of Resentment: Hell on Earth; March 22 – Forgiveness: Heaven on Earth; March 23 – The Easter Pentecost Mystery in Our Lives.** I hope you can join for any or all of the presentations at our Mission!

As I also mentioned last weekend, all parishioners are invited to take part in an important survey called the Disciple Maker Index (DMI). There is a half-page ad about this survey in this week's bulletin. Please take a moment to complete the DMI survey (it only takes about 10-15 minutes). This is an important opportunity to let your voice be heard about our parish. The survey is completely anonymous, and it is available online until March 31<sup>st</sup> at [catholicleaders.org/chicagodmi](https://catholicleaders.org/chicagodmi). Limited paper copies of the survey are also available at the back of church. Please return your completed paper surveys to the same place in church by March 31<sup>st</sup>.

Finally, last Sunday our RCIA candidates – Fabian Rodriguez, Nicole Serrano, and Adrian Zamora – participated in the Rite of Election at Holy Name Cathedral. At this ceremony, they joined hundreds of RCIA candidates from around the Archdiocese in being accepted as candidates for the Easter sacraments. The Rite of Election is always a beautiful ceremony (and this was just one of four services that is held at the cathedral because of the large number of candidates!) The photo on the left (below) is of all the candidates being called up into the sanctuary. The photo on the right is of our RCIA catechist, Mirusia Michalowski, holding up our parish Book of the Elect, in which is written our candidates' names. Please pray for Fabian, Nicole, and Adrian as they prepare for Easter!

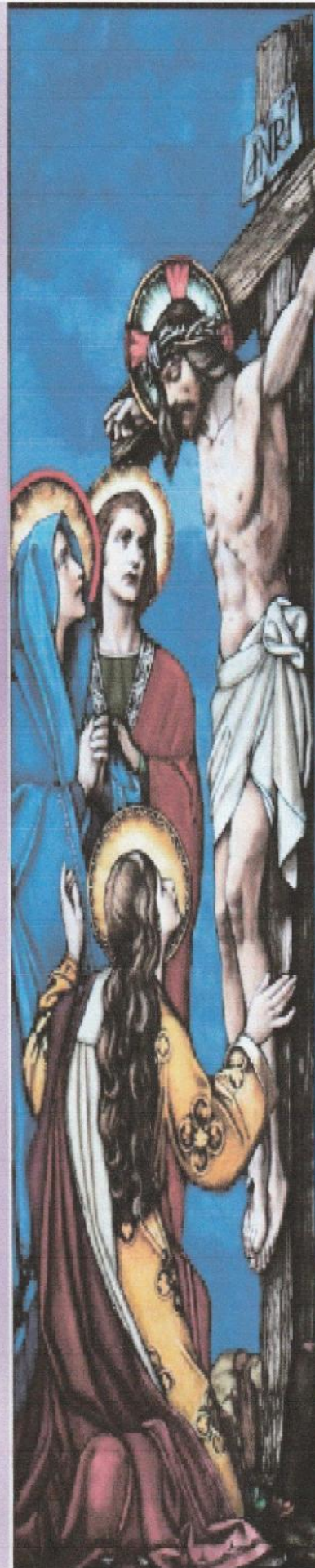
