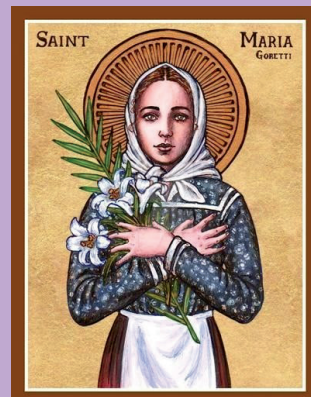

From the Pastor's Desk

I want to begin by thanking Fr. Michael Moore for presenting our 2023 Lenten Mission this past week. Because of our bulletin deadline, I needed to write this article before the Mission actually took place. So, even though I can't comment on it specifically here, I'm confident that it was a great Mission because I know that Fr. Moore is a wonderful, faith-filled mission speaker and priest. Again, I thank him for generously giving his time to us this past week. I also want to thank those of you who attended any of all of the Mission sessions; I hope that they were spiritually enriching for you.

There's a lot to talk about as we draw closer to Holy Week. First, please continue to pray for our RCIA candidates as they prepare for the sacraments of initiation at the Easter Vigil on April 8th. At the 11:30am Mass this Sunday, our candidate Nicole will undergo the 3rd Scrutiny in preparation for her baptism.

And as we ourselves prepare for Holy Week and Easter, one of the best ways to do that is by receiving God's grace and mercy in the beautiful sacrament of Reconciliation. We invite you to join us for Lenten confessions this Wednesday, March 29th at 7:00pm in church. As before, there will not be a prayer service. Instead, you are invited to come anytime between 7-8pm for individual confessions, and several priests will be available. Please note that the final opportunity for confession before Easter will be at the regular Saturday confessions on April 1st (and please note that there will be no confessions heard on Holy Saturday, April 8th).

Holy Week begins next weekend. Our full Holy Week schedule is posted in this bulletin, at the exits of church, and on our parish website. I hope that you can join us for the full celebration of Jesus' Paschal mystery by attending as many of the Holy Week and Triduum liturgies as you're able.

We begin with Palm Sunday on April 1-2, and we will have our regular weekend Mass schedule. On Holy Thursday, April 6, we celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00pm, and the church will remain open for Eucharistic Adoration until 11:00pm. On Good Friday, April 7, we celebrate the Passion & Death of the Lord at 3:00pm and 7:00pm (you can come to either one). Our Easter Basket Blessing will take place on Holy Saturday, April 8 at 11:00am. The evening of April 8, at 7:30pm, we kick off the 50-day Easter season as we celebrate the highest Mass of the year, the Easter Vigil. At that Mass, our RCIA candidates will be received into the Church through the sacraments of initiation. And on Easter Sunday, April 9, we celebrate the central mystery of our faith, the Lord's Resurrection. Please note that we will have one additional Mass on Easter Sunday to accommodate the crowds. Masses on Easter will be at 7:30am, 9:30am and 11:30am.

Finally, don't forget that all parishioners around the Archdiocese are invited to take part in the Disciple Maker Index (DMI) Survey, but the deadline to complete the survey is this Friday, March 31st. You can submit the survey anonymously. If you want to do it online, you can find it at catholicleaders.org/chicagodmi, but be aware that it will close at 11:59pm on Friday. Paper copies of the survey are also available at the back of church, but again, you need to return your survey by this Friday, either to the box at the back of church, or to the rectory.
