# From the Pastor's Desk

Many times throughout the year, in my bulletin articles here, I extend invitations to you. If you read my articles, then you know that is true. I invite you to this or that sacrament or special liturgy, or to this or that parish event, or to delve into the various things that the different liturgical seasons offer us. But the biggest invitation that I extend every year always has to do with one week – this week.

This, of course, is Holy Week, the most significant week of the entire liturgical year. I invite you to participate as much as you can in the beautiful, powerful, and unique events of this week. I'd like to break them down.

It all begins with Palm Sunday this weekend. This is one of the only Masses of the year where we start Mass at the back of church, as we listen to the Gospel story of Jesus' triumphant entrance into Jerusalem, and we imitate the welcoming crowds by holding palm branches. Later in the Mass we hear the entire story of Jesus' Passion and Death (this year we listen to Matthew's Gospel account).

On Tuesday, April 4, there is no special Mass here at the parish, but there is a special Mass at Holy Name Cathedral that day – the Chrism Mass. At that Mass, the priests of the Chicago Archdiocese renew their ordination promises, and Cardinal Cupich blesses the three sacramental oils to be used in all parishes in the coming year: the Oil of the Sick (for Anointing of the Sick), the Oil of Catechumens (for Baptism), and Chrism Oil (for Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Orders).

On Holy Thursday evening, April 6, we conclude Lent and begin the Sacred Triduum, the sacred three days. The liturgies on each of these days are unique. At 7:00pm on Thursday we celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper. At this Mass we witness the Washing of Feet, and we conclude with a Eucharistic procession, and then Adoration. The church will stay open for Adoration until 11:00pm on Thursday night.

This year, we also have another special event taking place at our Holy Thursday Mass. As we normally do during the Offertory on Holy Thursday, we will present our parish's three newly blessed oils, and we place them in the ambry (the container for the holy oils). This year we have a brand new, beautiful ambry that was very generously (and anonymously) designed and created by an HVM parishioner. Our new ambry will be installed in church before Holy Thursday, and we will bless it on Thursday evening. I encourage you to take a moment to look at the beautiful new ambry. Not only does it have glass so that we can see the oil vessels, but it also contains the Latin symbols for each oil, as well as our HVM Parish logo. I want to offer my sincere gratitude to the parishioner who shared their time, talent, and treasure to give our parish such a beautiful gift for years to come.

Moving on with the Triduum: on Good Friday, April 7, we celebrate the Passion & Death of the Lord. This is the only day of the year that Mass is forbidden. We will celebrate the Good Friday service at both 3:00pm and 7:00pm (so you have the opportunity to come to either one).

Our Easter Basket Blessing will take place on Holy Saturday, April 8 at 11:00am. Please note the time change. In the past, we celebrated the blessing at 12:00pm, but I would like to give more time that afternoon to our generous parish volunteers who will decorate the church for Easter.

The evening of April 8, at 7:30pm, we kick off the 50-day Easter season as we celebrate the highest Mass of the year, the Easter Vigil. At that Mass, our RCIA candidates will be received into the Church through the sacraments of initiation. And on Easter Sunday, April 9, we celebrate the central mystery of our faith, the Lord's Resurrection. Please note that we will have one additional Mass on Easter Sunday to accommodate the crowds. Masses on Easter will be at 7:30am, 9:30am and 11:30am.

Our full Holy Week schedule is posted in this bulletin, at the exits of church, and on our parish website and Facebook page. I hope that you can join us for the full celebration of Jesus' Paschal mystery by attending as many of the Holy Week and Triduum liturgies as you're able.





# 3rd Grade (Tuesdays)


We learned about how St. Patrick used a Shamrock to teach the Irish people about the Trinity. We also spent time learning about the Stations of the Cross.
