From the Pastor's Desk

I would like to first congratulate our 8th Grade Religious Ed. students who received the sacrament of Confirmation this past Monday. It is always a joy for me to see the young men and women of our parish stand before the bishop with their parents, sponsors, and families, and receive their last sacrament of initiation, thus becoming full members of the Church. At the same time, we know that the sad reality in parishes nationwide is that many young people stop coming to church after their Confirmation. Please join me, then, in praying for our Confirmandi, that they will stay close to Jesus Christ throughout their lives. Every year, when I watch them get confirmed, I pray that the power of the sacrament and the grace that comes from it will enkindle a flame of faith within their hearts.

Please also pray for our 2nd Grade and Special Sacrament R.E. students who will soon be making their First Holy Communion. Some of them will have their First Communion on Saturday, May 6th, and some of them will make it on Saturday, May 13th. Their names will be listed in the upcoming bulletins. As with our Confirmandi, please pray that our First Communicants will have a beautiful experience of God's love through the sacraments.

Don't forget that in less than a month we will celebrate our first HVM Spring Dinner & Raffle. It will take place on Saturday, May 20th in our new Hendle Hall. The raffle will offer five cash prizes: \$4,000, \$2,000, \$500, \$300, and \$200. You also have the option of buying <u>two</u> types of tickets, and please make sure that you are aware of the difference before you buy your ticket! The purple \$75 ticket gives you one admission to the dinner and open bar on May 20th, as well as one entry into the raffle. The yellow \$50 ticket gives you one entry into the raffle, but no admission to the dinner. However, please know that you do <u>not</u> need to be present at the dinner to win a raffle prize. In addition, we will livestream the raffle drawing; there will be a link posted on our parish website closer to the event.

There is an ad for our Spring Dinner & Raffle in this week's bulletin. Tickets are on sale at the back of church after weekend Masses, and beginning this weekend you have the option of paying by credit card at Mass. You can also buy tickets at the rectory. I hope that you can join us on May 20th, especially if you have not yet seen Hendle Hall. And even if you cannot attend the dinner, I hope that you can support HVM Parish with our new fundraiser.

And speaking of fundraising, I would like to offer an update, as well as my sincere gratitude, to all of you who have contributed to our parish's Easter collection, as well as the 2023 Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA). Our Easter collection is currently \$17,266. I say "currently" because we continue to receive Easter donations in the weeks following Easter Sunday. We have already made budget, and we will definitely go beyond that, so I want to profoundly thank all those who support our parish in this important collection.

Regarding the ACA, our goal this year is \$22,430.72. We currently have \$26,556 in pledges. I know this will rise, as we always receive additional pledges throughout the year. But even at this point, if we collect all our current pledges, we will receive a parish rebate of \$4,125.28. Every year we have been able to exceed our ACA goal and receive a rebate, so again, thank you to all of you who have been so generous!
