From the Pastor's Desk

If everything went as scheduled, then I hope that by the time you read this, our new parking lot will be complete. We have needed a new lot for some time (we had been doing patchwork for many years), so I'm very glad that we were finally able to complete this. You should know that we did look into the possibility of adding some parking spaces as part of this project, but because of Village codes (e.g., the amount of green space that is needed), our permit stipulated that we needed to stripe the new lot exactly as the old lot was striped. Nevertheless, I hope you like the newly paved lot.

As work continues on the church ceiling, we have a list of other renovation projects that we will be tackling in the coming year (and a number of these will be focused on the church, since that is the building that most parishioners have contact with, of course). If you would like to support us in these projects, the main way to do that is by continuing to contribute to our Sunday collection. The weekend collection is vital to the financial health of any parish.

But because our weekend collections – even when they are strong – do not cover all our expenses, we also rely on parish fundraisers. One of our popular fundraisers is going on right now, and this particular one gives you the potential to win money for yourself at the same time. Our Football Mania (FM) fundraiser is based on the NFL regular season schedule. Each FM ticket gives you 18 chances to win, one chance for each week of the season. FM tickets are \$20 each. The weekly prizes range from \$25 to \$400. There is a guaranteed winner each week, and it is possible to win more than once with one ticket. Tickets are on sale from now until the regular season begins in September. You can buy tickets at the back of church after Mass, at the rectory, or by contacting the rectory.

Next month our RCIA program will begin once again. RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is for adults who seek to become full members of the Catholic Church through Baptism (if needed), Eucharist and Confirmation. RCIA classes begin in September and lead up to Easter of next year (RCIA candidates are always received into the Church at the Easter Vigil Mass). Finally, I want to let you know about two things that are coming up in the next few weeks. First, **the** Solemnity of Mary's Assumption into heaven – a Holy Day of Obligation – will be celebrated on Tuesday, Aug. 15th. Masses on that day will be at 8:30am, 12:00pm, and 7:00pm.

Second, our Religious Education (RE) program is hosting a new event this year. Our first-ever RE Open House will take place on Sunday, Aug. 20th from 10:00am to 1:00pm in the school building. This event is open to everyone, not only to RE parents. We invite you to come on that day to tour the building, and meet the RE staff and catechists. Our RE program is one of our strongest ministries at HVM, so I hope you can come and check it out!

Mark Your Calendars!

We will be having our first open house on Sunday, August 20th from 10am until 1pm. We invite you to come and see our religious education building, meet our staff, and register your child.

The Registration days for the upcoming 2023-2024 year will take place at the Wagner Street Entrance of the religious education building on Tuesday, August 22nd from 4:00-7:30pm and Saturday, August 26th from 9:00am – 3:00pm. You **DO NOT** need to be a member of the parish to enroll your child in the Religious Education Program. In order to register your child in the Religious Education program, you will need the following:

Completed Registration Form Tuition Payment Copy of your child's Baptism certificate A copy of your child's 1st Reconciliation and Communion certificates, if applicable.

For a child to be eligible to receive a sacrament in the Religious Education Program they must meet the 2 year consecutive attendance requirement and all other requirements for that sacrament. Sacramental fees must be paid for each child receiving a sacrament this year in the Religious Education Program. The sacramental fees are:

Please note the tuition amounts DO NOT include sacramental fees. Tuition and Sacramental fees are to be paid at the time of registration. Families who pay in full at the time of registration will receive a \$15.00 discount. If a family is unable to pay the entire amount at the time of registration, payment options are available upon request, a \$15.00 administrative fee will be added to your tuition. A \$75 **NON-REFUNDABLE** payment along with any sacramental fees are due at the time of registration for those participating in a payment plan.

Our classes meet twice a month either Tuesday evening from 6:00-8:00pm and Saturday mornings from 9:00-11:30am. We also have homeschool options available. Our 1st Religious Education classes will take place on Saturday, September 9th and Tuesday, September 12th at the Wagner Street entrance of the religious education building. If you have any questions or need more information, please contact the Religious Education office.

We are still in need of teacher's aides on Saturday mornings for the upcoming year, the duties of an aide include: helping to supervise children in class, bringing the attendance and other things to the office, assisting the teacher with various tasks during class, being a substitute teacher (if comfortable) or assisting a substitute teacher.



The RCIA provides the opportunity to grow in the faith, supported by the community of Holy Virgin Martyrs Parish. You begin with a period of Inquiry followed by weekly Mass attendance, study of the faith, practices and doctrines of the Catholic Church, which leads to your initiation through either Baptism or a Profession of Faith, and the reception of Eucharist and Confirmation.

If you are considering joining the Church, we would love to help you in your journey! Or, if you know of anyone who is considering joining, consider extending an invitation to them!


