And speaking of generosity, I would like to thank our HVM Women's Club officers and members for hosting a Pasta Dinner & Raffle last weekend in Hendle Hall, and I want to thank all those who took the time to attend. At the time that I wrote this, I think we nearly sold out of tickets, which is always nice to see! Thank you for your support of the parish.

Finally, this coming Tuesday, Oct. 24<sup>th</sup> at 6:15pm in church, I will be offering a Teaching Mass for some of our Religious Ed. students. I will basically celebrate the Mass, while stopping throughout it to explain various aspects of it (e.g., why we do and say certain things at Mass, the symbolism behind some things, etc). Anyone is welcome to attend this Teaching Mass, if you are interested. All we ask is that you please do not sit near the front, as the front pews will be reserved for our Religious Ed. students.

### What We're Learning

### 4th Grade (Tuesdays)
