From the Pastor's Desk

As we approach the month of November, I want to remind everyone that we always begin November with two important liturgical celebrations. On Wednesday, Nov. 1st we celebrate the Solemnity of All Saints. This is a day when we thank God for the gift of all the saints in our Church's history who help lead us toward heaven. Please remember that All Saints is a Holy Day of Obligation (which signifies how important the saints are to our life of faith!) Masses will be celebrated on Nov. 1st at 8:30am, 12:00pm, and 7:00pm. We will have the relics of our parish's two patron saints, St. Beatrice and St. Maria Goretti, on display at these Masses.

The next day, on Thursday, Nov. 2nd, we celebrate the Feast of All Souls. On this day we pray that all our departed loved ones will join the saints in heaven. We will celebrate an All Souls Mass of Remembrance at 8:30am and 7:00pm on Nov. 2nd. At each of those Masses, we will read the names of all those who have been buried from our parish in the past year (since Nov. 1, 2022). We also invite you to bring photos or memorabilia of any of your deceased loved ones to either Mass on Nov. 2nd. We will have tables at the front of church to put your photos or memorabilia on display, and these items will be incensed during Mass.

And because November is a month where we focus on praying for the dead, there are a few items that we keep in church throughout the whole month. One of those items is our parish Book of the Dead. We invite you to write the names of your deceased loved ones in this book (again, it will be available all month in church). During the petitions at every weekend Mass in November, we will pray for all the souls listed in this Book. Next to the Book you will also find a poster with the names of all those who have been buried from Holy Virgin Martyrs Parish in the past year (these are the names that will be read at the All Souls Masses). Like the Book of the Dead, this poster will be on display during all of November. And I would like to thank parishioner Barb Piltaver, who every year puts together a beautiful design for this poster.

And don't forget that we always have another item in church to honor our deceased loved ones, and this item is available all year long. On a table at the back of church, near the main entrance, you will find books of memorial cards of departed loved ones. The book on the left is from St. Maria Goretti Parish (as they had been offering this type of book for many years). The book on the right is for Holy Virgin Martyrs Parish. In these books we keep memorial cards from people's funerals, as a way to always remember them every time we celebrate Mass in church. If you have a memorial card of a loved one that you would like to include in the HVM book, please just leave it in the small basket on that table at the back, and we will insert it in the book.

And may you – and especially all the children – have a happy and safe Halloween! Holy Virgin Martyrs, pray for us. May God bless you.

1st Grade (Saturday)


We spent time learning about St. Francis of Assisi. We learned how to take care of the gifts that God gives us.
