

So, at the 4:30pm Mass this Saturday, I will present them with their award. I would like to congratulate Steve and Cathy again and thank them for the many ways that they volunteer and contribute their gifts to our parish.

A few other things are taking place this weekend. First, our Women's Club is hosting their annual Fall Harvest Bake Sale. It will take place in the Gathering Room after all the Masses this weekend. Be sure to stop by to stock up on some delicious homemade treats for Thanksgiving. And as always, I would like to thank the Women's Club officers and members who put this together, as well as all those who so generously take the time to share their skills by baking and donating items for the sale. This great parish event and fundraiser would not be possible without the hard work and dedication of all those who contribute to it, so thank you!

Also on this weekend, our annual Giving Tree is set up near the main entrance of church. Every year, any gifts that are donated through this go to families that are helped by the Women's Center of Chicagoland, which is a pro-life crisis pregnancy center. Because gift cards are more practical in terms of collecting and transporting, the Women's Center is again requesting gift cards for donations, with \$25 as a suggested amount. If you would like to donate, please take a tag from the Giving Tree. When you buy a gift card, put the card and the tag in an envelope, write "Women's Center" on it, and drop it in the weekend collection at any Mass. However, please be sure to do this by Sunday, Dec. 3rd, as the Women's Center will be collecting the donations on Dec. 4th.


