As war continues to be waged in the Middle East and in Europe, it is very important for us as people of faith to pray for our brothers and sisters around the world who are affected by war and violence. I hope you can join us in praying this Rosary for Peace on Wednesday, Nov. 29th at 7:00pm in church.




