Happy New Year! As we look ahead to 2024, I pray that it will be a blessed year for you and your loved ones. I want to offer a belated thank-you to the parishioners who so generously gave me cards and gifts for Christmas. I greatly appreciate your generosity and your thoughtfulness. I also want to offer a belated thank-you to those who so generously gave of their time and talent to help decorate our church for Christmas (and I've heard from many parishioners about what a beautiful job they did). They are: Barbara Piltaver, Connie Fippinger, GeorgeAnn Zech, Andy Caccavari, Zerlina Kirchen, John Hansen, Veronica Chaidez, and some of our Rel. Ed. students. I also want to thank Catherine Widuch for her donation of several angels that we added to this year's decorations.

As part of the Christmas season, last weekend we celebrated the Feast of the Holy Family. This weekend we continue to celebrate the Christmas mystery with the Feast of the Epiphany, which commemorates the visit of the Magi to the Baby Jesus. Their visit signifies Jesus' birth being made known to the world. It signifies that Jesus' divinity as the Son of God was revealed to the world, and that is essentially what the Gospel and the Church's mission is all about – telling the whole world that Jesus is the Son of God and the Savior of the human race.

Now, normally the Christmas season lasts for one more week, but the way that the schedule works out this year, we have a shortened Christmas season, just as we had a short Advent season. So, the Christmas season actually ends this Monday, Jan. 8<sup>th</sup>, with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord (this feast is normally celebrated on a Sunday, but again, the schedule is unusual this year). The event of Jesus' Baptism marks the transition between Christmas (focusing on the child Jesus) and Ordinary Time (focusing on the adult Jesus and His public ministry). So, after this Monday, we begin the liturgical season of Ordinary Time.

I also want to remind everyone that, even though we just had our first HYPOD raffle drawing for 2024, you can still buy HYPOD tickets at any time (and there are still 51 chances to win with every ticket that you buy!) The next drawing will take place this Monday, Jan. 8<sup>th</sup>, and then every Monday after that. The weekly prize is \$100, except on the last Monday of each month, when the prize is \$500. Tickets are \$10 each. You can purchase tickets at the rectory, or they are also available all the time in the pamphlet rack at the back of church (the green tickets). Just fill them out and return your tickets and payment in an envelope in the Sunday collection at any time, or drop them off at the rectory.

Finally, last month I had announced that Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Parish held a dedication ceremony at the former St. Maria Goretti Church. The Greek Metropolitan, Archbishop Nathaniel, dedicated the building as a Greek Orthodox worship space, and Cardinal Cupich was present as well. The Archbishop then announced that, as a way to honor the legacy and history of St. Maria Goretti Parish, they plan to build a shrine to St. Maria Goretti on the premises. There are no details yet about this, as the planning has not begun, but I wanted to let you know about it. I believe this is a very gracious gesture on the part of the Greek Orthodox Church, and it will give witness to the fact that that building has served Catholic parishioners for decades, and will now continue to serve Greek Orthodox parishioners in the worship of God.
