From the Pastor's Desk

As I mentioned in my article last week, Jan. 18-25 is the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. I had said that it is important for us to pray for unity as, sadly, the Christian faith in our nation today is divided among many denominations.

But another thing that divides so many people in our nation – whether they be Christian or non-Christian, believers or atheists – is the subject of abortion. I mention this because this Monday, Jan. 22nd is the Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. Jan. 22nd was chosen as the date for this Day of Prayer because it is the anniversary day of the 1973 *Roe v. Wade* Supreme Court decision. *Roe*, along with the 1973 case *Doe v Bolton*, legalized abortion through all nine months of pregnancy.

Now, you might ask why there is still a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children, given the 2022 Supreme Court decision of *Dobbs v. Jackson*? The thing to remember is that, while *Dobbs* did overturn *Roe*, it did not outlaw abortion. Rather, it returned that power to each of the 50 states to decide for themselves. This is why, in some states today (including here in Illinois), abortion continues to be legal through all nine months of pregnancy. And this is why the U.S. Bishop are still asking us to pray for the legal protection of unborn children.

I've participated in the pro-life movement for many years, even since before I was ordained a priest. And I've done that because I'm convinced that, when it comes to the question of whether human life has dignity at the very beginning, we cannot get that wrong – because if we get that wrong, we will get so many other things wrong. If our society does not see human life as having value and being worthy of protection from the first moment that a new life comes into existence, then there is nothing to stop us from chipping away at the dignity of human life in its later stages. If the unborn are classified as less than human based on their size, their dependency, etc., then what is to stop us from classifying other people as less than human based on other characteristics – race, age, appearance, lack of mental or physical abilities, etc.? Let us continue, then, to pray this week for unity among Christians, and for the legal protection of unborn children.

Finally, I'm happy to report that, thanks as always to the generosity of parishioners and friends of HVM Parish, our 2023 Christmas collection succeeded our budget. We continue to receive donations in the weeks following Christmas, but as of two weeks ago, our 2023 Christmas collection had surpassed \$28,000, and we had budgeted \$25,000. This also exceeds our 2022 Christmas collection of \$23,481. Thank you for your generosity!

Holy Virgin Martyrs, pray for us. May God bless you.
