From the Pastor's Desk

It seems like I'm often behind on the items that I discuss in my articles here, but that's because we need to submit our bulletin materials well in advance. So, I would like to offer a belated thank-you to our Liturgy Committee members who so generously gave of their time (and sweat!) to help undecorate our church from the Christmas season (which was no small task!) I am very grateful to Barb Piltaver, Connie Fippinger, and George Ann Zech for all of their hard work.

I would like to give everyone a heads-up about two things taking place next weekend. First, next Saturday, Feb. 3rd is the feast of St. Blase. In connection with his feast day, it is a traditional practice to offer a blessing of throats (as one legend says that St. Blase miraculously healed a boy who was choking on a fish bone by praying over him with lighted candles). Thus, for the St. Blase blessing of throats, the minister holds a pair of candles (unlit, of course!) Next weekend, then, we will offer individual blessing of throats after all the Masses.

Second, next weekend will be the first of three weekends that I will promote the Archdiocese's 2024 Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA). There will be an Announcement Weekend, a Commitment Weekend (when we offer an in-pew pledge process), and a Follow-Up Weekend. I ask for your patience as I take time to explain the importance of the ACA for the Archdiocese, as well as for HVM Parish.

Finally, since I have a little room in my article this weekend, I thought I would again offer some Catholic trivia. As always, try to challenge yourself and not use Google to answer these! I'll post the answers next weekend.

February is National Heart Month. In association with this month honoring heart health, I will be offering Blood Pressure Screenings after the masses on Sunday




2/4/2024. Learning our blood pressure numbers can give us some important information associated with our own heart health.


