Liturgically speaking, 2025 has been an extraordinary year. What I mean is that it is not common for a special feast day to be celebrated on a Sunday, and yet this weekend we have our fourth exceptional Sunday this year. In addition to Saints Peter and Paul (June 29th), Exaltation of the Holy Cross (Sep. 14) and All Souls (Nov. 2), this Sunday, Nov. 9, we celebrate the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica. I will be speaking about this at Mass this weekend, since it is not often that we focus our attention on the Lateran Basilica. The one thing I will mention about it here is that there is an inscription on the Basilica that declares it to be “the Mother and head of all churches of Rome and the world.”

This weekend we also honor the veterans among us, the brave men and women who have served our country. For those who enrolled names in our Veterans Day Spiritual Bouquet, those names are displayed on posters at the front of church this weekend, and they are also printed in this week’s bulletin. We will also have a blessing of veterans at the end of each Mass this weekend. May God bless our veterans!

Don’t forget that, during this month of November, we continue to pray for our beloved dead. We invite you to write the names of your deceased loved ones in our parish Book of the Dead, which will be available all month in church. During the petitions at every weekend Mass in November, we will pray for all the souls listed in this Book.

The next Family, Faith & Fun Night, hosted by our Religious Ed. program, will be this Saturday, Nov. 15 from 5:30-8:30pm in the basement hall of the Rel. Ed. building. This free event is open to all children and their parents (you do not need to be a Rel. Ed. student or a parishioner). 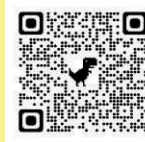
